PCNSL is a rare and highly malignant lymphoma¹

Approximately 1,900 patients are diagnosed per year in the US, or 0.45 cases per 100,000 people.²



The CDC has updated its ICD-10 codes to include PCNSL.

ICD-10 Code: **C83.390**

This ICD-10 code should be used for **PCNSL of the brain, meninges, spinal cord, or NOS**.

The addition of this new code will help the CDC to identify high-level incidence data and aid in the advancement of the identification and management of patients with PCNSL.
